Your child will be covering the following areas of the curriculum this term:

English	Books studied – The Princess and the White Bear King, Earth Shattering Events
Maths	Multiplication and division, money, statistics, length and perimeter, and fractions
Science	Rocks and soils, Plants
Humanities	Mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes
PE	Netball, dance, gymnastics and football
Art/DT	Art – Hot and cold colours, DT – Food technology
RE	Sikhism
Music	We develop tempo, dynamics, duration, timbre, texture, Kodaly Rhythm System, body percussion, instrumental percussion, pitch, applying what we learn to the instruments we play and musical structure.

PSHE	Keeping myself safe, rights and responsibilities
