Task 1 – PSCH

Task 4– Computing

Collect some data from friends and family to present in a graph or table. It could be anything from people's favourite fruits, the colour of their hair or how they get to school/work each day. Can you input your data in to Microsoft Excel as a table? Can you work out how to present it as a graph? Screenshot your graph or table and stick it in your Home Learning book as evidence.

Task 5 – Knowledge & Understanding of the World—linked to Science

Carry out an investigation at home which shows a reversible change in materials. Present your findings using the experiment structure of 'Question/ Method/ Results/ Conclusion'.

Challenge: Can you now find 2 everyday examples of irreversible change. Present your findings in a suitable way.

Make a model of a Roman soldier's shield.

Challenge: Can you make parts of the shield 3d?

Task 7—Citizenship

Create a poster of what 'Respect' looks like in the following settings:

- In the community

Task 8– Experience
